Prime Responsibilities / Interactions

- Ensure various outings / trips offered to the membership as identified (but not limited to):
 - Established Annual Trips (i.e. Harmon Creek, Llano River, etc.)
 - Identify New Freshwater Experiences are available as requested by the membership
 - Set Up Lodging and logistics guidelines as required
 - Coordinate food / Travel arrangements among participants
 - Maintain calendar of events
 - Communicate progress and upcoming events at General Meetings
 - Secure required approvals and funding through the Executive Board

- Identify and propose to the Executive Board new outing opportunities.
